



This practical course is suitable for anyone who wishes to develop their love of ceramics, whether you are an absolute beginner or have previous experience with clay.

To help you master the craft of pottery, you can bring ideas of your own, or respond to the range of construction and decorating techniques our friendly and experienced tutor will teach you.

All our art and design courses develop creative skills and a personal approach to artwork. They are based on an understanding of media, materials and the work of other artists.

Course duration: 12 weeks

What will I learn?

This non-qualification course is open to both beginners and more experienced students.

The course guides you through the techniques of pinching, coiling and slab building with different clays. Colour and decoration will be added later using slips, glazes and oxides.

Towards the end of this 12 week course you can work towards making a larger piece of work - possibly a large coil pot, slab pot, tile panel or sculpture.

How will I be assessed?

Your tutor will offer assistance to beginners and advice for those with more experience. In order to receive a Runshaw College Achievement Certificate, it is important that you achieve the required standard agreed for this course. (Your tutor will discuss this further at the start of the course).

What are the entry requirements?

There are no specific entry requirements, apart from enthusiasm and the willingness to learn.

What progression is there?

This course will prepare you for progression to further art courses at Runshaw College.
