Enhance your career prospects by studying a prestigious University of Central Lancashire (UCLan) degree at Runshaw College. If you'd like to study closer to home in a supportive learning environment, our innovative university courses are available in a range of subjects.

What's more, as a Runshaw degree student you'll also have full access to the services, facilities and support of both UCLan and Runshaw.

Foundation Degrees

Designed by employers, Foundation Degrees are qualifications in their own right, equivalent to the first two years of an Honours Degree. They can also be 'topped-up' to a full Honours Degree usually through one more year of study.

BA/BSc (Hons) Degrees

Our degrees are designed to develop analytical, intellectual and essay writing skills. You'll undertake the first year of your degree at Runshaw College and then progress to complete the second and third years at UCLan.

Foundation Entry

These courses are designed for students who have the ability to study for a degree; but may not have the necessary formal qualifications to go straight on to their chosen programme. These are typically a 1 year programme studied over 2 days a week.

Teacher Training - PGCE / Certificate in Education

Our Certificate in Education and Post-Graduate Certificate in Education (PGCE) qualifications offer routes into teaching within Further Education. On achievement of the course you will be eligible to apply for QTLS (Qualified Teacher Learning and Skills) status, which will also allow you to work as a qualified teacher in secondary schools. You may also be able to undertake your teaching practice at Runshaw which is an Ofsted Outstanding Institution and a National Teaching School.

Access to Higher Education

Access to HE courses can be your passport to an entirely new career! They provide students aged 18+ with the skills and qualifications for progression to Degrees, Foundation Degrees, other higher level studies, and career pathways.

2 We offer:

- **Access to Health & Social Care / Nursing and Midwifery**

As degree entry requirements vary, you are strongly advised to research the entry requirements for any intended future degree to ensure that your chosen Access to HE course is the right course for you.

3 Your course may be free...

Depending upon your age and circumstances your course may be free. If not, you may still be eligible for an Advanced Learner Loan to cover the cost of your tuition fees.

As Advanced Learner Loan repayments only start once you are earning over £25,000 a year, if you never earn this amount you'll never make any repayments.

What's more, if you successfully complete your Access course and progress to and successfully complete a Degree / Higher Education course, the balance of your Advanced Learner Loan will be written off.

- Payment by instalment


