



# BTEC Level 3 Applied Science

Welcome to Applied Science BTEC Level 3 at Runshaw College. This course is for those who enjoy finding out how things work, and those with an enthusiasm and genuine interest in science. Applied Science covers all corners of science, dipping in to aspects of chemistry and biology, combining this with maths and industrial science.

Within the science department here at Runshaw, we give students all the support they need, and our dedicated science study area facilitates study time away from timetabled lesson time. Students can access resources in an environment with only other science students. As well as the study area, our dedicated staff are on hand and run support sessions to ensure students are well placed to succeed. Students of Applied Science are assessed in a slightly different manner to those taking singular, A Level routes. The BTEC Level 3 has 2 exam units per year with the remaining units being assessed through coursework. Assessment is continual, including investigations, practical work, reports, presentations and posters.

Looking further ahead and our students have gone on to further study in areas such as biology, biomedical science, nursing, pharmacy and chemistry. Not all decide to go on to higher levels of study, and alternatively students do progress in to work and a career within the scientific industry. If you enjoy taking part in real life practical work, and the prospect of trips to Chester Zoo and prestigious universities excites you even further, then choose Applied Science at Runshaw College.
