The BTEC Level 3 Extended Diploma in IT is intended to give learners a good grounding in all aspects of computing and will provide the means to study a specialist area at university. L1 and 2 courses are assessed via internal portfolio building, with the level 3 course being assessed by a range of different methods including examinations, controlled assessment and internal portfolio building.

Entry Requirements:

Level 1: a minimum of 1 x Grade 3, 1 x Grade 2 and Maths or English Language at Grade 2.

Level 2: a minimum of 4 x Grade 3s, please note you will also resit your Maths & English if they are not a 4 or above.

Level 3: a minimum of 5 x Grade 4s, including English & Maths.
