Services and facilities

There are three open access Study Zones at Runshaw College – Coniston, Patterdale and Langdale. Each is a well-equipped area specifically designed for independent study.

We have excellent facilities:

- 500 study spaces
- Bookable teamwork rooms and pods for group work
- Individual workspaces
- More than 200 PCs
- Advance booking for PCs
- 8 Express PCs with a short log on for checking emails or quick prints
- Colour printing, scanning and copying
- Free wi-fi and 'bring your own device' facilities including charging points and storage lockers
- Study equipment loan such as calculators, ear phones and maths equipment
- Freecycle – a free stationery exchange
