What will I learn?

The courses will focus on reading, technical writing skills and planning and creating a range of personal and work documents such as letters, reviews and forum posts. The courses will also develop confidence in your speaking and listening skills. The speaking and listening tasks focus on effective communication in discussion groups and individual work. In addition to class time, you will complete around 3 hours of independent study per week.
