

Pre-Access Social Science

The study of Social Sciences opens up diverse opportunities in areas such as the criminal justice system: HM courts and tribunal service; welfare services; the police, prison and probation services; youth and community work; and local government. For those wishing to pursue a career in Psychology, career paths may include: clinical, health, sport, forensic and neuropsychology.

Funding

This course may be FREE if you...

- You are unemployed (and looking for work) and in receipt of JSA, Universal Credit, Child Benefit and Carers Allowance*.
- You are earning less than £18,525 annually (before tax)*.

If this criteria doesn't apply to you, then you could also either pay in three instalments or pay the fee in full.

If you successfully complete your Access course and progress to and successfully complete a degree/higher education course the balance of your loan could be written off. This means your Access course could be free!

*Please note that if you are aged between 19-23, you will need a full L2 qualification to access this funding.
