Therapeutic Counselling

This part-time qualification gives learners the knowledge, skills and competencies to work as a therapeutic counsellor in an agency context. It is designed to lead to an employed or voluntary role in a counselling agency in both health care and non-medical settings. Learners with sufficient experience can also begin working as independent practitioners in private practice. The course is delivered one day a week over two years.

Duration

2 years.

Learning Method

This course will be delivered through blended learning. This means a mix of classroom-based lessons and a small amount of online lessons.

What will I learn?

The course involves experiential elements and learning that will involve some personal disclosure and associated personal development activities. The course incorporates a minimum of 100 hours formally-contracted counselling (one-to-one), with at least 5 different clients in an agency setting.

Entry Requirements

Level 2 Certificate in Counselling Skills and Level 3 Certificate in Counselling Studies or their equivalent.

Interview – applicants need to be able to demonstrate their ability to handle the level of academic work required and show a willingness to take responsibility for oneself. An enhanced DBS is required. Residential is not included in the fees.

Why should you study at Runshaw?

- Learners regularly engage in group supervision on Levels 3 and 4 - preparing them for clinical practice.

Progression

Successful completion of this course will allow you to apply for higher level qualifications. Please be aware that if your long term goal is to work in an area with vulnerable adults or any person under the age of 18, it will be necessary to undergo a disclosure and barring services (DBS) check at your place of employment. If you have a criminal conviction this may exclude you from working in some job roles.

Please note that there will also be a mandatory two night residential trip during the course which promises to be a very valuable learning and personal development experience. This is an additional cost of approximately £220.

There will be a maximum of £930 donation from the college to go towards supervision and counselling sessions, additional costs for this will have to be covered by yourself, if you wish to partake in more.

To fund this course, you have the option to apply for an Advanced Learner Loan to cover your fees, subject to eligibility criteria. The course fee does not include BACP membership.

You could also either pay in three instalments or pay the fee in full.
