

You will study a variety of topics and develop key skills in Data Analysis, Cyber Security and Programming.

The BTEC Level 3 Extended Diploma in IT is intended to give learners a good grounding in all aspects of computing and will provide the means to study a specialist area at university. The two year course is split into 3 semesters, once you complete the mandatory IT qualification in semester 1 you will have the option to tailor your course to your own interests. You will be able to opt for additional IT and Computing modules or a specialism in Esports in Semesters 2 and 3. ## **Entry Requirements:**

Level 1: a minimum of 1 x Grade 3, 1 x Grade 2 and Maths or English Language at Grade 2.

Level 3: a minimum of 5 x Grade 4s, including English & Maths.
