- Want to build self confidence

- Would benefit from smaller classes and extra support

Students will be working towards Entry Level 2/3 and will possess Basic English and Maths Skills on entry.

Foundation Studies and Skills students can study with us for 3yrs and have the opportunity in the 4th year to access a Supported Internship (real life work with local employers).
