Health & Social Care Extended Diploma Level 3 at Runshaw College is ideal for anyone wanting to progress into a wide range of careers in health or social care. In the past we have had students progress into careers in areas including Adult nursing, Children's nursing, Mental Health nursing, Midwifery, Paramedics, Occupational Therapy and Special Needs Teaching.

The course is equivalent to 3 A-Levels and therefore students can also decide to explore options in higher education, using their qualification to enrol on to degrees not necessarily linked directly to Health and Social Care including Psychology, Criminology and also Care, Community and Citizenship.

Most of the teaching staff in the school are former health and care professionals and so are able to bring a wealth of previous experience and authenticity to the classroom. Our staff are former Registered Nurses, Midwives, Mental Health Nurses who have worked in areas such as social work and care of people with special needs.

The course involves studying a variety of units, all linked into social care and health. Areas covered include anatomy, nutrition, lifespan and additional needs.

Over two years, students will complete over 100 hours of work placement, working in settings such as, care homes, nursing homes, hospitals and day-care centres. Work placement enables students to build their confidence, communication skills and team working skills. During their time on work placement, they will be supported by placement staff and dedicated placement

mentors, who visit the students on each placement, monitoring their progress and providing additional support.

Entry Requirements:

A minimum of 5 x Grade 4s, Maths or English Language/Literature at Grade 4 and the other at Grade 3. Must complete a DBS. Grade 4 in English Language and Science if intending to progress to nursing.
